Dear Parents, Families and Students:

For the parents I have not yet met I hope that this letter serves as an introduction for myself and for the classroom your children and I will share.

This is my thirteenth year teaching grade five and my eighteenth at the school. I grew up here on the South Shore, though mostly in the Chester area. I have also taught in the Canadian North for five years. I am married with three children and live in Chester Basin where we operate a small farm.

It is my hope to build the following components into my classroom and my teaching:

- Building on student knowledge that they bring to the classroom and helping them achieve both educational and personal standards.
- Helping students become well-rounded in their knowledge of academics and the world around them.
- Getting to know students and their families so that our classroom and my teaching can reflect the diversity that exists in our class community and beyond.
- Adjusting my teaching so that students can best learn, including various grouping strategies and cooperative learning environments.
- Being a role model for the same expectations that I have for students.
- Incorporating technology into the classroom and the curriculum.
- Encouraging critical thinking.

The basic expectations that I have for students include:

- Coming to school every day, ready to learn.
- Helping me build the classroom community: working with others and showing personal responsibility and respect.
- Working toward fulfilling their personal expectations as well as their families' and mine.

It is extremely important to me that you, our families and our community, be involved in the students' learning. I need your help to meet these goals for my students. I know that time is a precious thing for many working parents and guardians and it is my intention to both keep the lines of communication open as well as keeping the classroom open for families. I also would like to have you come visit or volunteer in our classroom.
